Friends,

You can ask any theatre artist why they love working on plays like Wait Until Dark, and their answer will always be some version of this: it's so much fun to tell a great, smart, classically creepy story. This is a perfect tale to tell as autumn settles in - it feels like the right story to immerse oneself in as the evenings come more quickly, as the leaves catch fire and abandon their posts. Nostalgia always arrives in the early fall; we're reminded of being young and unsure, of feeling the possibility of the world. This is, of course, where we find our determined heroine at the top of the play. She's weary and a bit unsure of herself, the autumn air is making her restless, and the world is full of unrealized possibility. These are, we know, the perfect conditions for becoming a heroine: when we add to the mix that she is newly blind and finding her way in a world of heightened senses and hidden danger, the stage is set for the perfect thriller. This adaption of Knott's classic is penned by Minnesota playwright Jeffrey Hatcher, and his take on the script gives the characters a gritty and complicated new life. HALEY WALSH STAGE MANAGER


